Public Health orders regarding proof of vaccination for British Columbia:
The provincial proof of vaccination requirement has been lifted.

There is no Provincial Health Officer order requiring events, services or businesses to check proof of vaccination. Individual businesses and event organizers may continue to require proof of vaccination for entry to their events.

Physical distancing, masking, scanning proof of vaccination are no longer required by the Health Department. At the Community Hall, organizers can decide to lift or to retain options that your participants agree to.

Main Hall capacity: 200

Lower Floor Meeting area: 80

Keeping in mind that the Community Hall is in use by diverse individuals for a variety of activities, we will be maintaining enforcement of basic hygiene standards designed to reduce risks for Hall users.

Such as:

clean hands

removing your own garbage, recycle, compost

dust mopping/sweeping the floor before departure

Sanitizing frequently touched surfaces such as door handles and light switches when leaving.

The Sanitization Check Lists will remain at both entrances for organizers (or their representative) to initial before leaving the building as confirmation that each activity has completed the basic hygiene protocols.
